

**EVHS Baseball Booster Club
October 7, 2015 Meeting Minutes**

- On October 7, 2015 the East View Baseball Booster Club meeting was called to order at 6:00 pm by Steve Cantu.
- Joy Sansom submitted the minutes from the May 6, 2015 booster club meeting. Motion was made by Scott Dupree to approve the minutes and seconded by Charles Hickman. They were approved unanimously.

- Steve Cantu moved on to the agenda:
 - Treasury Report – Charles Hickman reported that...
 - Payments have been made to D & L Printing for the bulk mailer and to the Georgetown Community Center.
 - Sponsorship Update – Kris Cutler reported.....
 - Mailer was sent to D&L Printing to distribute using the list of businesses from the Georgetown Chamber of Commerce.
 - Kris needs a group of individuals to help her follow-up with Sponsors from last year and to contact new sponsors. She will be holding a meeting before the next booster meeting on November 7 at 5:30 pm.
 - Also mentioned was that player ads would be sold again this year for the media guide. Each player that sells a business add will get a 50% discount on their player's ad.
 - Fundraiser Update - Steve Cantu reported...
 - Our first fundraiser will be the Hit-A-Thon. Coach Pullen did this fundraiser last year and did very well with it. Players will get pledges for their hits. We need to include GYBA.
 - Our other fundraiser will be Meet the Patriots. A date still needs to be set as soon as possible so the cafeteria can be reserved.
 - Community Service – Steve Cantu reported.....
 - This year the players will again be doing the Toy Drive for the Georgetown Boys and Girls Club. The players can get community service credit hours for this. Last year some of the players also attended the party of the Boys and Girls Club and help had out the toys to the participants.
 - Background Checks –
 - Everyone needs to complete the background check process on a yearly basis in order to volunteer for the baseball program. If you have completed this process for other organizations are the school then you don't need to repeat it. The check is district wide and covers all schools and functions.
 - New Business -
 - Hitting Facility – Charles Hickman has been working with district representatives in getting the hitting facility name approved. There is a list of items that need to be completed for this process. One of those items will be addressed at the 10-14-15 school board meeting. In addition to the building name, there will also be a plaque placed on the building thanking those community members who donated time and material to the building process. The booster club needs to start thinking of what we want to name the facility for the next meeting.
 - Patriot Season - The booster club meets one a month, most of our funding comes from the fundraisers and the sponsorships we raise in November and December, volunteers will be needed to work concessions, and then to do the End of Season banquet which is for all players, not just varsity.
