November 5, 2014 Meeting Minutes

- On November 5, 2014 the East View Baseball Booster Club meeting was called to order at 6:10 pm by Steve Cantu. Participants were welcomed and reminded that we meet the first Wednesday of every month.
- Joy Sansom submitted the minutes from the October 1, 2014 booster club meeting. Minutes were approved by Charles Hickman and seconded by Valerie Thedford .
- Steve Cantu moved on to the agenda for November 5, 2014.
 - Treasury Report - Valerie Thedford reported.....
 - Beginning balance for November 2014 was \$1,795.96. Plus a check for \$364.23 to reimburse the booster club for the benches in the player locker room for a total of \$2,160.19. After the quarterly taxes were paid the remaining balance is \$1,960.19.
 - Sponsorship Report – Stephanie Jeffries-Webb reported.....
 - Minuteman Press has said they could do a trade-out as in past years. It was stated that we need something more concrete than a verbal agreement. Still deciding on scoreboard. We need an answer by the end of the week.
 - Cains wants numbers. i.e. how often the field is rented. Etc.
 - Steve Cantu reported that First Tx Bank and City Lights both have committed for renewal of scoreboard signs.
 - Someone suggested if Minuteman Press doesn't commit to contact Mel's.
 - Wag-a-bag will commit to a single.
 - We will be doing a mail out to the sponsors in the football media guide that Stephanie and Joy pulled together.
 - Charles will send out an email to the baseball booster club on how to get sponsorships.
 - Fundraiser Update – Charles Hickman reported.....
 - Charles spoke to Dr. Denny yesterday – Student Counsel has been awarded the Paver Fundraiser.
 - Charles brought to the meeting an opportunity of the mulch fundraiser that the EVHS Band has done over the last few years. The first year they raised around \$9,000 working one Saturday to deliver mulch. Sales are completed on-line, compile list of customer and addresses and coordinate delivery. Second year they made a little less. Charles will follow-up and talk to the band committee about logistics of the project. Mulch was purchased from Austin Wood Recycling in Cedar Park. Mulch was sold for around \$6/bag.
 - Suggested that on a Saturday the players would go to local neighborhoods and put out flyers and have order forms with them to take orders.
 - Company delivers mulch to EVHS. If customers order 5 or more bags of mulch it would be delivered to place they specify.
 - Keep in mind that we would have about 44 total players helping on a weekend day vs. 100 band members.
 - Delivery would take place on March 15, 2015

 - Currently 22 kids in the class. November will be spent with time on the field, December will be weights.
 - Wants to do a toy drive in December for the Boys and Girls Club of Georgetown. Donations can be dropped off at the field house or given to any of the players. Need flyers to post around school.
 - Should have the schedule within the next week.
 - Spring Break we will be playing ball!
