

**EVHS Baseball Booster Club
December 2, 2015 Meeting Minutes**

- On December 2, 2015 the East View Baseball Booster Club meeting was called to order at 6:04 pm by Steve Cantu.
- Joy Sansom submitted the minutes from the November 4, 2015 booster club meeting. Motion was made by Scott Dupree to approve the minutes and seconded by Charles Hickman. They were approved unanimously.

- Steve Cantu moved on to the agenda:
 - Coach Randy from Mortal CrossFit attended the meeting to talk about the strength and conditioning class that is being offered to the baseball players in January 2016. Coach Randy has done several of these classes for Georgetown HS over the last several years over the summer. Will focus on Olympic lifts to gain speed and strength and other drills.
 - 45 min workout (mon, tues, and wed) for four weeks
 - Warm-up, strength conditioning and drills. (No pullups, presses, etc.)
 - Cost will be \$15.00 week.
 - Will have two coaches available for the class depending on the number of players. For Georgetown they had around 30 players with two coaches. The goal is to have the players learn to watch each other and to make sure the proper technique is being used.
 - Can go to the web portal to sign up or send a check with the player to the first class.
 - Will start the first week of January at 5:00.
 - Last four weeks

 - A waiver will need to be filled out and signed for injuries, etc.
 - Treasury Report – David Tyndall reported that...
 - Balance is \$9,000 as of November 30th. This month we have had \$1,800 in sponsorships, and 200 in merchandise. Plus an expense for PO box \$56.00. So right now we are around \$11,000.
 - Sponsorship Update – Kris Cutler reported.....
 - Kris handed out an update of the sponsorship which included current paid sponsorships and a list of businesses that have been contacted.
 - Discussed the drop dead date for sponsors to get us there forms. The media guide needs to be completed by the first district game around spring break. So the end of February at the latest.
 - Kris contacted the school shop to see if they would repair the picnic tables. Booster club will pay for any materials. Coach Pullen was going to see that the table got delivered to the shop.
 - Diamond Queens will be run by Jacki James in 2016. Kirby Tyndall has spoken to Mrs. James. Jennifer Hickman said she would be the point of contact for the Queens this year and coordinate with them.
 - Kris needs someone to help her remove field signs of the sponsors not renewing.
 - Player ads should be ½ price for a sponsorship or an advertisement sold.
 - Please let Kris know if you sell any ads/sponsorships so she can update the spreadsheet.
 - Joy Sansom will contact positive image about team pictures this year. Set up for Feb 2 -3.
 - Community Service – Steve Cantu reported.....
 - This year the players will again be doing the Toy Drive for the Georgetown Boys and Girls Club. Tentative date for the toy delivery is December 16th right after school.

- Fundraiser Update - Steve Cantu reported...

- Merchandise –
 - We want to try a different sale option this year.

 - Need to determine what out percentage is.
 - Do we need to include sales tax or does the company pays.
 - It was brought up that we have some low income students wanting to try out. What assistance is available? Coach Pullen suggested The Locker.
 - An estimated cost for the players is junior varsity team would need to purchase a shirt and hat for \$30.00. Varsity would be \$50.00 due to needing two hats.
 - Coach Pullen stressed that money will not be an issue to play. If it is, please contact Coach Pullen.
