














2023 UIL BEHAVIORS AND EXPECTATIONS

OVERALL ACCEPTABLE BEHAVIOR

Antagonizing, disrespectful or derogatory yells, chants, songs or gestures.

Booing or heckling an official's decision.

Criticizing officials in any way; displays of temper with an official's call.

Refusing to shake hands or give recognition for good performances following a game.

Blaming loss of game on officials, coaches or participants.

Laughing or name-calling to distract an opponent.
